3) <b>Purpose</b> of the processing	As with any disclosures to the police, there must be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A legal duty to disclose, or</li><li>• A sufficiently important reason to disclose AND a legal basis for doing so.</li></ul> <p>This includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Prevention of Terrorism Act (1989) and Terrorism Act (2000)</li><li>• The Road Traffic Act (1988)</li><li>• The Female Genital Mutilation Act (2003)</li></ul>
4) <b>Lawful basis</b> for processing	To enable the HCO to receive information concerning a patient for the purposes of an investigation, the following Article 6 and 9 conditions apply: 6(1)(c) processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject and: 9(2)(g) – Processing is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest on the basis of Union or Member State law which is proportionate to the aim pursued and which contains appropriate safeguards We will consider your rights established under UK case law collectively known as the “Common Law Duty of Confidentiality”*
5) <b>Recipient or categories of recipients</b> of the shared data	The Police (or other judicial authorities)
6) <b>Rights to object</b>	Not applicable
7) <b>Right to access and correct</b>	Not applicable
